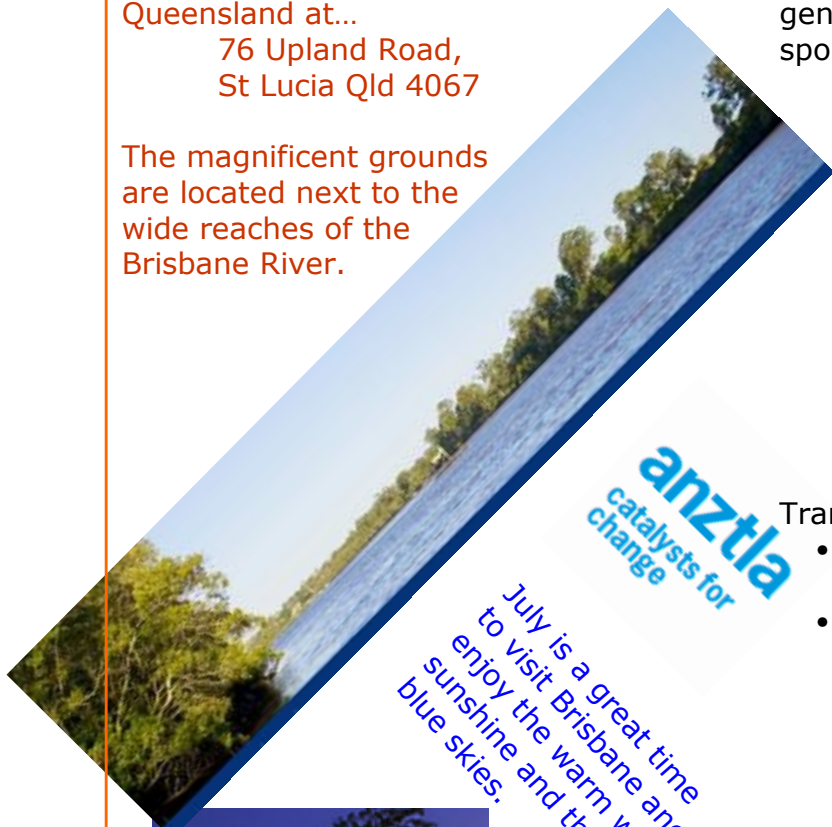


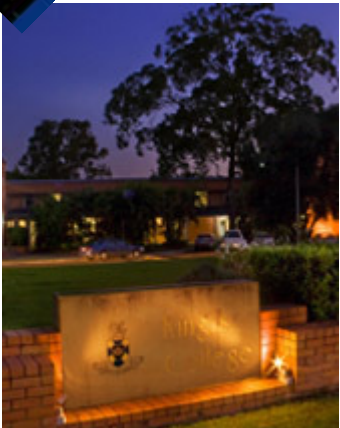
King's College is located within the precinct of the University of Queensland at...

Guest Speaker Bios...

- Anne Robertson:** Anne has worked in most areas of librarianship in a career spanning over 25 years, but primarily in cataloguing. Anne now works independently as training and project management consultant. Anne is the Australian representative and Deputy Chair on the Dewey Decimal Editorial Policy Committee, a ten-member international board.
- Bruce Winter:** Bruce is currently the Principal of Queensland Theological College at St Lucia, and Director of the Institute for Early Christianity in the Graeco-Roman World. Bruce has extensive qualifications in theology, biblical studies, politics and history, in addition to being an internationally renowned author with numerous research projects currently under way.
- Christine Bruce:** Christine is Professor in the Faculty of Science and Technology at QUT. She researches information literacy, information technology learning, graduate capabilities, and research study and supervision. Christine conducts seminars internationally and is regularly sought as a conference keynote speaker. In 2010 she received a State Library Board of Qld Award for contribution to information literacy, information literacy education and research.
- Lynn McAllister:** Lynn McAllister has been at QUT since 2003 and has worked on numerous projects including the Australian ePortfolio Project. Lyn has also worked in the QUT Library as Liaison Librarian with the Faculty of Education and lectured in the Faculty of Science and Technology at QUT. Lyn's areas of interest are evidence based practice and eLearning design, in particular, development and support of the ePortfolio pedagogy to enhance students' learning outcomes. Lyn has academic qualifications spanning librarianship and education
- Adam Lowe:** Adam is an ordained Anglican Priest and a sessional lecturer at St Francis Theological College. He is Assistant Curate at Noosa Anglican Parish. Adam is a registered psychologist and prior to ordination specialised in organisational consulting, particularly relating to senior HR strategy. His teaching and research interests include New Testament studies and the psychology of Clergy.
- Pauline Allen:** Pauline is Professor at ACU and is Director of the Centre for Early Christian Studies, a Fellow of the Australian Academy of the Humanities and Research Associate in the Department of Ancient Languages at the University of Pretoria, South Africa. Pauline's research interests are early Christian literary genres, especially homilies, letters, hagiographies, and ecclesiastical histories; post-Chalcedonian Christology; Mariology; text editions.
- Ian Stoodley:** Ian is a qualitative researcher in the Faculty of Science and Technology at QUT. Ian has first-hand experience as a postgraduate student, supervisor of postgraduate students and researcher of the supervision of postgraduate students. He has been a high school Teacher-Librarian, and special Librarian in linguistics and theological libraries in Africa, Australia, Central Asia and Europe. Ian recently completed his doctoral studies in which he explored professional ethics, with specific application to information technology.
- Lena Volkova:** Lena is the President of the Oral History Association of Australia—Qld Branch and has interests in oral history, digital storytelling, new media, museums and galleries, cultural heritage, heritage of the Pacific's, community and public history.
- Carolyn Russell:** Carolyn is a medical practitioner with an extensive background in counseling, educating health professionals and Christian wholeness.
